

Senior Theoretical Knowledge Instructor, Flight Training and Engineering

Responsibilities:

- Deliver Theoretical Knowledge Instruction to CPL/ATPL training programme
- Maintain students' training records in a timely and accurate manner
- Manage the planning of student and practical training activities
- Monitor student progress and schedule progress tests
- Prepare, maintain, and update courseware and training materials to ensure compliance with the regulatory syllabus and current industry practices
- Participate in training and professional development of standardization in collaboration with other business stakeholders
- Assist in the programme and course administration planning; and
- Perform any other duties as assigned by Director, Flight Training and Engineering or his delegates

Requirements:

- A recognized degree or equivalent professional qualifications
- At least five years' service in aviation and flight training experience, preferably related to technical knowledge of ATPL
- A proven record in instructing aviation courses, preferably as part of a Flight Training Organization (FTO), and teaching EASA ATPL technical knowledge subjects will be an advantage
- Efficient skill in Microsoft, particularly construction of PowerPoint as training materials, is essential
